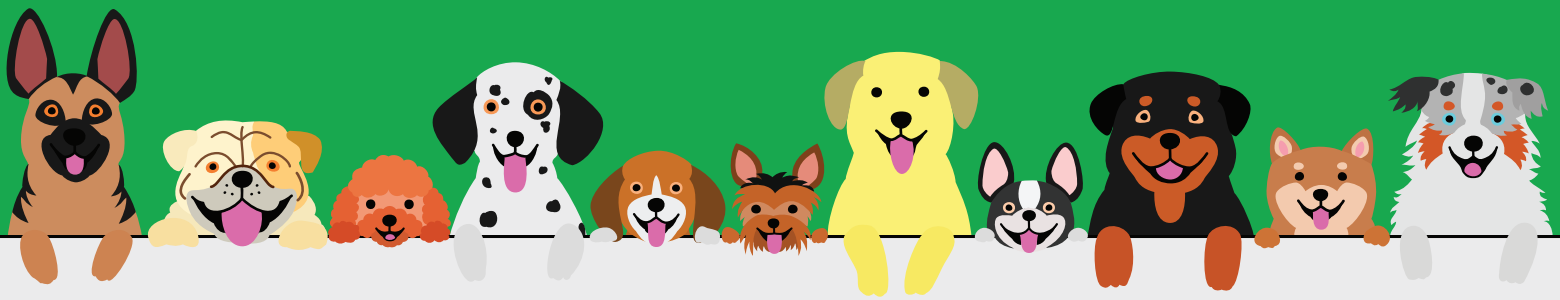


CLASS NAME	WHO SHOULD ATTEND?	PRE-REQUISITE	OBJECTIVES
PUPPY 1	Dogs <6 months needing foundational life skills & manners.	Age appropriate vaccines based on Vet's recommendation.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Intro to basic manners: Come, sit, stay, leave it/drop it. • Self control exercises, potty training, puppy behaviors & biting, socialization. • AKC Star Puppy Test • Limited to 8 dogs/class.
PUPPY 2	Dogs who want to build upon skills from Puppy 1/ Adult Basic Manners class.	Puppy 1 or Adult Basic Manners at NPAB or instructor approval.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ability to add duration, distance & distractions to the skills acquired in Puppy 1/ Adult Basic Manners. • Increased focus on impulse control, which includes not jumping, intro to loose leash walking & calm behaviors at doorways. • Limited to 6 dogs/class.
PUPPY 3	Owners who want to apply learned skills in real world scenarios in a class setting.	Successful completion of Puppy 2.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • How & when to increase or decrease criteria when working on mastering skills. • Intro to off leash skills. • Some classes held outside (on leash).
ADULT BASIC MANNERS	Dogs >6 months old needing an intro to or refresher of manners and basic skills	Age appropriate vaccines based on Vet's recommendation.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Intro to basic manners: Come, sit, stay, leave it/drop it. • Addressing leash manners, counter surfing, jumping on visitors, etc.



CLASS NAME	WHO SHOULD ATTEND?	PRE-REQUISITE	OBJECTIVES
ADVANCED CLASSES — CANINE GOOD CITIZEN	Owners who want to have their dog test for the Canine Good Citizen (CGC) test.	Highly advised that Levels 1-3 have been completed or instructor approval required. Dogs must be comfortable in a class and friendly with dogs & people.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Prepare for and obtain the CGC designation.
ANXIETY & AGGRESSION — REACTIVE ROVER	Owners who want to decrease reactivity in their dogs.	Trainer approval is required prior to signing up for class.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Give owners skills & tools to calm their dogs when stressed. • Increase dog's comfortability & confidence around other dogs.
ANXIETY & AGGRESSION — SHY DOGS	Dogs who are shy with new people or dogs, or when in new situations.	Trainer approval is required prior to signing up for class.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Improve the overall confidence & comfortability of the dog & its handler.
SPECIALTY CLASSES — FUN & GAMES	Owners who want to improve handling & having fun with their dog.	Successfully complete Puppy 1.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dogs will play obedience games, cognition games, or practice agility-style skills.

<p>SPECIALTY CLASSES — LOOSE LEASH WALKING</p>	<p>Owners who want to become comfortable with walking their dog in different settings.</p>	<p>Dogs must be comfortable in a class and friendly with dogs & people.</p> <p>If not a prior client of NPAB, instructor approval is required.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • For your dog to walk politely on a loose leash in a variety of different settings. • <i>Classes offered in Spring - early Fall.</i>
<p>SPECIALTY CLASSES — OUTDOOR DISTRACTIONS</p>	<p>Owners whos dog struggles with focusing on you while on walks or in public.</p>	<p>Dogs must be comfortable in a class and friendly with dogs & people.</p> <p>If not a prior client of NPAB, instructor approval is required.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To improve the focus of your dog while outside with distractions, such as other dogs, wildlife, traffic, etc. • <i>Classes offered in Spring - early Fall.</i>
